Q1 Epistimi Application Form for Greece July 2024 Program

The Epistimi leadership program is an introductory leadership program with space for 25 graduate student or postdoc participants. The Greece 2024 Program is funded by the Henry Luce Foundation and will take place in Athens, Greece during the week of July 15-19, 2024. Graduate students and postdocs identifying as women and working in some aspect of the energy sector are invited to apply. The selection process will be by committee and guided largely by the intention to create a diverse group of participants across energy sectors (wind, solar, geothermal, energy storage, biofuels, etc.) and geographical location. The content of your personal statement and leadership project is particularly important for how we evaluate your application. We also require a letter of recommendation from someone who is familiar with your energy work, such as a research advisor or a professor at the university where you studied.

Please make sure you have prepared answers to all the questions in the application instructions document. You cannot save your work and come back to it at another time but must submit it in one sitting which should take less than 10 min if you have prepared your answers.
